

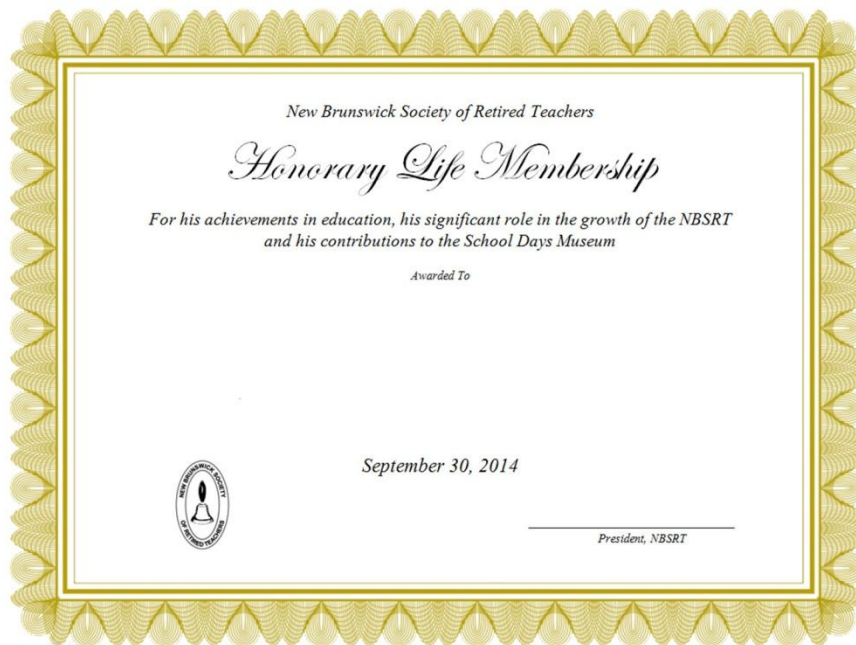
Honorary Life Membership Award Nomination Guidelines

NBSRT members may be nominated for an "Honorary Life Membership Award" based on the following criteria as long as the member:

- 1) **Is a member in good standing of a local branch of the NBSRT**
- 2) **Has given service to his/her branch at the executive level and/or senior committee level over at least a five-year period. He/she should be extensively involved in the Branch's activities, and be a visible "presence" - someone who would really be missed if not available.**
- 3) **Has given significant service to the Provincial NBSRT at the executive level. This could include some or all of the following over at least a five-year period: Table officer, Committee Chairperson, ACER-CART Representative, Group Insurance Trustee, and the completion of significant projects such as the review of the Constitution, or contributions of similar value.**
- 4) **Contributed actively to business meetings at both the local and provincial levels.**

SUPPLEMENTARY PROCEDURE:

Nominations, fully supported by written information, are to be submitted to the NBSRT Recording Secretary by December 1st of each calendar year for consideration and ruling by the Executive Officers of the Provincial Body.
